Supervisors and invigilators should check both the morning and afternoon schedules prior to sitting of examination papers for the day.
 Supervisors and invigilators should also check the date, time, subject or paper number before opening the envelope.

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 Candidates should sign the Declaration form after the code of conduct has been read to them to signify that they have understood and accepted that they shall abide by them. This should be done before they write their first paper of this examination.
